Vision: The purpose of the Scholarship Program is to help build a healthy community through increased involvement of recreational activities for our youth and families by providing assistance in financing and programming.

Guidelines:

- * Eligibility - Any age, Any location
- * Approved applicants will need to pay **half** of the program/membership cost
- * Maximum individual funding will be \$40.00 per year
- * Maximum household funding will be \$120.00 per year
- * Eligibility will be determined on a case - by - case basis
- * Financial awards will be disbursed directly to City of Ashland/Ashland Parks & Recreation
- * All financial forms will be kept confidential. Information is not intended for any other purposes.
- * Service hours will be required as part of the acceptance of the award. 1 hour/\$20 credit (see end)
- * Distribution of current funds: 40% to Free Lunch Status, 35% to Reduced Lunch Status, 25% to other
- * Current Ashland Parks and Recreation family account must be paid in full or upon receiving award
- * Applications and awards good for one year from date of award
- * Awards are given only for Ashland Parks & Recreation regular programs or BCC memberships
- * Awards are limited, please return immediately
